Nevertheless the parents/guardians understand that YE will not assume responsibility for the purchase thereof from public/private establishments and their concealed consumption at any organized events.
- YE does not tolerate any behaviour by achievers which does not reflect the spirit and philosophy of the Organisation and reserves the right to disqualify any such students without refunding any fees paid.
- The parents/guardians shall make good and indemnify third parties for any losses or damages caused as a direct result of their son/daughter's actions and in no circumstances will YE assume responsibility for such actions;
- The parents/guardians of all members of a Junior Achievement (Young Enterprise) Company shall jointly and severally make good and indemnify third parties, including but not limited to customers, suppliers, shareholders etc., for any losses, debts or damages sustained or caused by such Company and in no circumstances will YE assume responsibility for any such losses, debts, damages;
